ADD 1 MORE	MODEL	REPETITION	INSTEAD OF "SAY + ___"	REDUCE QUESTIONS
Use 1 more word than your child does	Model what you want them to say	Repetition of words over and over	Use target phrase instead of requiring language	Use declarative language instead
IMITATION	VISUALS	A WORD A DAY	GESTURES	GIVE THEM 1
Imitate your child to help them learn they can imitate you	Use objects or pictures when talking	Target the same word all day	Use sign language or gestures that carry meaning	Give them one item then model asking for more
KEEP IT SIMPLE	PARALLEL TALK	TAKE A BREAK	SELF TALK	CHOICES OF 2-3
Use simple phrases & sentences	Talk out loud about what your child is doing		Talk out loud about what you are doing	Model "I need ___ or ___?" for your child to give them a choice
BE FORGETFUL	BE SILLY	FOLLOW THEIR LEAD	SING	KEEP IT FRESH
So they ask for what they need	Unexpected humor makes it fun to learn	Child-led play leads to more gains	Teach using songs	Explore something new to increase engagement
SCRIPTS	ROUTINES	WAIT TIME	REPEAT IT BACK	ASK OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS
Use the same phrase 3 ways to teach grammar	Use the same routines so children know what to expect	Gives kids more time to process	Say what they just said to honor communication attempts	Avoid yes/no questions
